

Face Masks

In order to protect campers and staff, KinderCamp requires the wearing of masks or cloth face coverings during the camp day. Masks must be worn whenever 6 feet of social distancing is not possible,

Your child is exempt from wearing a mask if your child:

- Cannot safely wear, remove, and handle masks.
- Has difficulty breathing with the face covering or cannot remove the cover without assistance.
- Has severe cognitive or respiratory impairments.
- Can only wear the type of face covering that presents a potential choking or strangulation hazard.
- Cannot breathe safely with a face covering.
- Is unable to wear face covering safely due to a behavioral or intellectual impairment.
- Needs to communicate with people who rely on lip reading.

***Please provide a note from your health care provider noting the applicable reason for the exception.**

If your child is unable to wear face masks when required in our program, they may need to be withdrawn from the program.
